### Some random thoughts by the pastor...

Paul, in our second reading this weekend from his letter to the Galatians, makes a startling statement! He says: 'I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that the gospel preached by me is not of human origin. For I did not receive it from a human being, nor was I taught it, but it came through a revelation of Jesus Christ.' We are not used to hearing someone claim that they have AUTHORITY directly from God! Yet, this is what Paul is saying. This doesn't mean that he is separate with James and Peter, or his Jewish Religion (though he was at odds with them at various times). One area that they do agree, however, is in the area of service to those in need. Paul will collect from the churches that he founds, funds that can be distributed to those in need. So... how is it possible that Paul who declares personal authority, disagrees with certain mandates of James and his Jewish Religion, and still be in union with James and Peter (the leaders in Jerusalem) and his Jewish Religion? The unity that exists is made possible because they share oneness in Christ/God. God is good.
