## Some random thoughts by the pastor...

The pathway to God – as Jesus reminds us in the Gospels – is narrow and not travelled easily. One reason is because walking the pathway to God contradicts our human tendencies. The image that we create for ourselves makes sense to us. It is the image that we most often project to the world. It is the image that provides us with good and bad feelings about ourselves. It is the image that pushes us forward or crushes us in disappointment. We have, however, another image which God gives to us. When we are very young, we readily see and relate with this image. As we grow and develop, we lose touch with it and begin to think that the image that we create is the only image. The road to God is so narrow and feels conflictual (without peace) because the path is counter -intuitive. It conflicts with the values and way of life promoted by our created image. Jeremiah and many other prophets recognize the difficulty presented by this manufactured image, and Jesus seeks to help us to see that we - most likely - will feel divided before we experience union. God is good.

Parish updates: Work has begun on the installation of the mini-split cooling system for the church building. Electricians have been working in preparation of the hardware (outside condensers and inside 'blowerheads'). The work on the blower-heads (they will be visible above the windows in the church proper) will begin this week. I don't have a time schedule (of when work will be completed) but we are on-our-way!
