Some random thoughts by the pastor...

Evangelization has come to mean – for some – getting people to church/Mass. Jesus approaches evangelization from a different perspective in today's Gospel reading from Luke. They have nothing to prove. They have no truths to argue. They have no status of superiority. They have no agenda. They are servants who are available to God's healing mercy in their own lives and share this healing mercy with others. One side-effect of this approach is community. God is good.

Parish representatives and priests of Saint Mary, Saints John & James, and CTK met on Tuesday, June 21st. It was an amiable meeting in which we agreed to create a *vision statement* in which we will explore possible ways that the three parishes can work together.
