Some random thoughts by the pastor...

There is a fine line – it seems to me – between acknowledging injustice and willingly being of service. Martha – in our Gospel story from Luke – acknowledges an injustice (Mary not helping her) and displays resentment (a by-product of unwillingness to serve). Many have commented on this story. Some have sided with Martha. Others have sided with Mary. Our Jewish heritage invites us to recognize the need we have to blend both Martha and Mary. We need to listen and we need to actively be responsible for each other (action and contemplation). God is good.

Parish updates: We have signed a contract with Carjon to install an air cooling split-system in the church building. The cost of the project – which is the last of the Capital Campaign projects – is \$94,932. The wait time on the equipment will vary, but work will soon begin. Progress is being made on the exterior of the (former) school building. We intend to paint the façade of the building facing the parking lot this year.

The parish representatives of Saint Mary, Saints John & James, and CTK will not meet again until Wednesday, September 7th. We will seek to develop a more detailed approach to the three parishes working together (over the next 3-5 years) at that meeting. It has been asked that we create a proposal for the Diocesan Pastoral Planning Board to review by October 1st. The more detailed proposal will be published in our weekend bulletin and your input will be asked before it is submitted to the Diocesan Planning Board.
