Today's first reading from Genesis is a completion of the story began last week. Two characteristics are explored by this story: respect and freedom. This week he demonstrates freedom by evoking mercy for the people of Sodom and Gomorrah. Hospitality and mercy are the children of respect and freedom; and respect and mercy are the children of experiencing God in another. God is good.
