## Some random thoughts ....

Our first reading from Sirach invites us to choose life rather than death. I suspect that we are in agreement with choosing life. The difficulty is that sometimes we choose death thinking that it is life! Is there a foolproof way to know what life is and what death is? Some might say that following the church's teachings, sacrificing, doing penance, praying, giving alms to the poor are sure ways that we know that we are choosing life. Jesus in today's Gospel from Matthew responds: 'Maybe'. Choosing life always involves transformation of who we accept ourselves to be. Our egos/limited self can easily take all of these wonderful actions and use them to strengthen our determination to remain separate from God and others by demanding that we can prove our goodness. Jesus says, 'All that effort is wasted energy, unless we are open to learning from our failures.' When Jesus teaches that we are to keep the commandments, he focuses on transformation and not on success. This is the wisdom of which Saint Paul speaks in our second reading today. God is good.

**Parish Updates**: Based on input from the majority of parishioners, we will put off investing in the updating of the church proper. During the Lenten season we will offer the Stations of the Cross each Monday evening at 6:30 in the church proper. We use reflections based on several of Pope Francis' teachings and documents. The Stations take about 30 minutes. We also offer (as we do during the Advent season) a daily meditation booklet.
