Some random thoughts

Jesus simplifies the 600+ commandments that were being promoted by the religious leaders of his day to two commandments: love God and love neighbor ... and everyone and all of creation is neighbor. accepts – by reducing the number of commandments to two – the complexity of the human person. Jesus encourages us to experience our limitations so that we can more readily rely upon God's help. A key ingredient to our accepting God's help is verbalizing to another who is trusted – our temptations and shortcomings. Confession is used to get rid of our individual sins. Verbalizing to a trusted friend our temptations and shortcomings is asking 'why am I tempted, why can't I get rid of my shortcomings?' Getting rid of individual sins prevents us from seeing the roots and therefore the bigger picture of corporate or institutional evil. That is always encouraged by both our individual egos and the corporate/institutional egos. Multiple commandments work as a screen or distraction so that we can't see evil on a corporate or institutional level. Step five of the Twelve Step spirituality of AA is: Admitted to God, to ourselves, and to another human being the exact nature of our wrongs. This is not an easy thing to do and is so necessary for us to recognize what is true about ourselves and what is false. God is good.

Parish Updates: Grandma's Attic continues to provide assistance to all who need clothing or small household items. There are several sites in the area that provide assistance to all who are in need of food. We do receive telephone calls asking for assistance, and we are grateful that Darlene (Diocesan Satellite Office) helps us in fulfilling these requests whenever possible. During the Lenten season we will offer the Stations of the Cross each Monday evening at 6:30 in the church proper. We use reflections based on several of Pope Francis' teachings and documents. The Stations take about 30 minutes. We also offer (as we do during the Advent season) a daily meditation booklet.
