## Some random thoughts ....

Temptations are part of every person's life. They find their origin in a necessary part of who we are: our ego. The creation of ego is a natural process. The ego's primary way of relating to people and the world is through the employment of pride. Pride can be boastful and belittling. The temptations that govern our lives are summarized in today's Gospel story from Moral theology speaks of three major Matthew. sources of evil: the world, the flesh, and the devil (that is, evil that takes on a life of its own). Unfortunately, the primary focus most often is upon the flesh (anything to do with our bodies). We see all three sources in today's Gospel. The response that Jesus makes to each is empowered by his awareness that he is loved – both humanly and Divinely. Love takes us beyond our limited and finite selves and helps us experience a reality who is unlimited and infinite. It is only that experience that has the power to see and ponder the temptations that keep us addicted to our small and finite self/ego. God is good.

Parish Updates: We are into the Lenten season and spring can't be very far away! We are making one change in the Holy Week schedule. The Good Friday Service is changing from 7:00 pm to 3:00 pm. It is our hope that this will afford those who would like to participate in the Service (and who don't drive at night) the opportunity to participate.
