Some random thoughts

Thirty five/forty years ago a book was published with the title. Original Blessings. It was almost immediately condemned because the book called into question the accepted theology concerning original sin. Today's first reading from Genesis (which is a much older story than the garden of Eden story) is entirely about the original blessing that Abram/Abraham receives. We hear: 'I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you and curse those who curse you. All the communities of the earth shall find blessing in you.' Imagine if we had experienced these words instead of hearing: 'You are born in sin.'? Jesus (who is also the Christ) is not unique. If we make him unique then we fail to experience God's original blessing to us. God is good.
