Some random thoughts

Theologically there are two understandings of the resurrection. The oldest theology is found in the east. The west develops another theology later. This later theology about the resurrection is greatly influenced by the western culture moving toward intellectualism (clarity and understanding) and individualism. So, western theology depicts Jesus rising from the tomb BY HIMSELF. Jesus conquers death alone. Eastern theology continues to connect with mystery (cloudy and unknowing) and community. So, eastern theology depicts Jesus rising with an INFINITE MULTITUDE with him. All of creation – including humans – conquer death by the power of God. Both theologies (that is, people talking about God) have their strengths and weaknesses. One reality that both accept as true is that belief in the resurrection isn't enough. Resurrection is an experience that transforms our lives. God is good.
