

Some random thoughts

When we are not aware, we keep secrets from ourselves. Ironically, we blind ourselves from seeing, but others see 'our secrets' very well in the way that we relate with them and others. We experience and live in the reality that we are connected with a person who is beyond us. It is an experience of our trusting this connection (when we stop holding and hiding from ourselves), and then discover that God does continue to uphold us. We no longer need to make excuses or to feel embarrassed. We are better able accept when we are wrong and when we are right without need to project the former and to highlight the latter. God is good.
