Some random thoughts

The words and stories of Jesus were much too radical for even the Gospel writers to fully accept, and so they interpreted them, making them more palatable. Today's Gospel parable is a good example. Jesus operates from the perspective of God freely relating with us, and with God's help – grace – we respond and reciprocate. Most probably, when Jesus tells today's parable, he is speaking from the perspective of what God is doing for us. God's generosity is so abundant that we feel that it is wasteful. The interpretation that is substituted is much less abundant and wasteful and focused more on morality. This is done by shifting the responsibility to us. No longer is God indiscriminately throwing seeds everywhere. Now, if the soil isn't fertile, it is because we have failed to make it fertile. We are the cause of the seeds not growing. We are responsible for the waste. The shift is dramatic. We move from God's infinite abundance to our limited scarcity. God is good.

Parish Updates: We did make an internal loan: Maintenance Account to General Account. We will repay the Maintenance Account during the next fiscal year. The Boy Scouts have reactivated and are holding weekly meetings in the Parish Center, parking lot, and play ground on Wednesday evenings. Several scout leaders have been repainting the third floor of the Parish Center. We are grateful. We will be having some minor work done behind the rectory, and have about 8 flowering trees planted on the embankment between the parking lot and the playground. Finally, we will be having the carpets cleaned in the church proper in the near future.
