Some random thoughts by the pastor...

The parable of the sower and the seed (today's Gospel story from Matthew) is fairly familiar to us. Generally we interpret the parable from our perspective (i.e. we have to make the soil 'good' so the seed can grow). The paradox presented by the parable however, is that God is so generous that God isn't concerned about where the seed falls! God knows that at least some of the seed will grow, and when it does it will produce 'a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold.' God isn't concerned about the numerous ways that we fail. God is concerned about us. This always produces abundantly. God is good.
