Some random thoughts by the pastor...

The human tendency is to take offense. The person who is driving in front of us isn't driving fast enough, doesn't start immediately when the traffic light changes, uses the car brakes frequently, leaves a gap between cars, and we take offense. It is easier presently - to see people taking offense on the political scene. The Canaanite woman (in our Gospel story from Matthew) could have easily taken offense at what Jesus says to her. She does not, leaving room for Jesus to respond positively. When we don't take offense, we often provide the space necessary for a change to happen. It isn't easy to not take offense, and not taking offense can lead to healing. God is good.
