### Some random thoughts by the pastor...

When Matthew's Gospel is written, a hierarchy is forming. Many of the original disciples of Jesus have died. The writer is intent on establishing an ongoing connection with these disciples. One way that he makes this connection is by identifying who they are and the role that they assume. Peter, in particular, is highlighted and given additional authority. The Gospel writer can't eliminate (nor does he want to eliminate) just how slowly the disciples' understanding matures. Peter and the other disciples carry with them a mistaken image of who God is and therefore who Jesus is. It takes the pain and fear of Jesus being arrested and crucified that has the power to shake them out of their established image. Then, transformation is free to begin. God is good.

Parish Updates: The side doors of the church (being 60 years old) do not meet code. The new doors being ordered (to meet code) have to be 36" wide (3 feet). The opening is 58" wide. So we will have one 36" door and an operable panel just in case we need the full 58" to remove or take in an item. Several trees have been removed from behind the church building. We will be looking to plant arborvitae once the area is cleared.
