Some random thoughts by the pastor...

Teresa of Avila offers us three steps in our journey in God. The first is practicing a discipline in order to create a routine of prayer. The image that she uses is our drawing water from a deep well. It can be arduous work initially, but with time and practice it can become our routine. This initial step is primarily about us and our efforts, but it cannot end here. The second step that Teresa offers us in our journey in God begins with our efforts being diluted by God flowing through us. She continues with her analogy: We, in this second step, no longer draw water from the well. Now we channel water to irrigate. When something is diluted, it often loses clarity. Paradoxically, Teresa speaks of this segment of the journey opening us to receive an infusion of divine light. The third step in our journey in God is a union with God in which our individualized self 'slips away'. The final segment of her analogy reveals that we are no longer involved in the irrigation process. All is watered by rain falling to the ground. This does not mean, she says, that all is blissful, that we no longer encounter troubles, stress, that we don't err. It does mean, however, that an ongoing transformation causes us to be surprised by our not taking offense as often, by our greater capacity to experience our connection with other people and all of creation, by our willing participation in service to others. 'The contemplative life,' someone once said, 'is not a matter of achieving some artificial state of perfection available only to the spiritual elite, who glide past the obstacles that throw off the rest of us. It is a matter of being so fully present to the moment that we cannot help but catch a glimpse of God in all that is.' God is good.

Parish updates: The church parking lot will be a busy place once again with the start of school. Each day school buses pick up and drop off students in the lot. Kent County Water has begun to install new pipes on Legris. Water to the buildings will not be adversely affected, but there are exposed pipes temporarily in place along the sidewalks. There are orange cones marking where the pipes are.
