The self that we create with our minds is so fragile that it is in need of constant success and praise. This self needs the continual feelings of pleasure and gratification in order to continue its existence. Without these continual feelings of gratification, the fragile self is gloomy and surly. Life is an unnecessary burden. Jesus, in today's Gospel story from Luke, points to what is necessary for us to grow beyond the initial stages of human and spiritual development. He says, in effect, if you are in constant need to receive adulations, pats on the back, and/or recognition, you are living in the self that you have created. The prophet Habakkuk points to the person that God creates who is free to do without gratification (for a time) because they experience a loving relationship that exists between God and themselves. What way of life is operating most often for you? God is good.
