Some random thoughts by the pastor....

We become so used to living with limitations and placing limitations on everyone and everything that we unconsciously - in our minds - limit God too! We fail to realize that what we ordain as determined by God, are really cultural and religious biases. The limitations that we set are not necessarily sinful, but they can prevent us from being open to the infinite ways that God comes to us... which is sad. Does this mean that anything goes, or that nothing is sinful? No, anything that is unloving is sinful because God is not present. (Sin is the absence of God/love. Therefore, love is always about living in community. This necessitates love to guide us into personal relationships. Sin is the absence of community, and therefore there is no need to be guided by love. We can easily and freely promote our opinions as God's law.) Jesus' strongest reactions happen when limitations and exclusions are declared as ordained by God. He ignores the limiting laws of Sabbath when love guides him to heal. He ignores the laws that declare people unclean and impure because love moves him to be inclusive rather than exclusive. He dismisses the limitations and the merit systems of his religion (and those in authority), and declares openly and often that God dwells with each person and all of creation. How do we miss seeing this reality in the Gospels and in the letters of Saint Paul? Yet, we often do and there are plenty of 'people in authority' who are driven to impose a way of life that are governed by limitations, meritocracy, sin and guilt. Seeing the world from this perspective can be easier (with its limitations) than being open to experience love (which is without limits). God, who is love, is limitless, and God dwells with us. There is no separation between the Divine and the human declares the Incarnation! Or as Jesus says in today's Gospel story from Luke: '... [God] is not God of the dead, but of the living, for to [God] all are alive.' God is good.
