Some random thoughts by the pastor....

It is easy to lose track of what is important. When we do, our priorities exclude people. It generally takes our world collapsing and the shock that comes with such an unexpected happening for us to have a chance to see that our priorities are misplaced... and not everyone does. The self that our minds create is neither good nor bad, but we can live much of our lives unaware that we are being driven by opinions based on likes and dislikes, what is convenient or inconvenient for us, what provides us with good feelings about ourselves by having bad feelings toward others. Whenever we are exclusive, call a way of life as unnatural, determine that people are not born with a particular orientation but choose their orientation, we are judging and excluding. It is most easy to be directed in this unconscious state, to prioritize unimportant (but manageable) decisions (e.g. what are we to wear), over important (but less manageable) decisions (e.g. accepting the grace of God to remain open to love). When we prioritize what is unimportant, life seems easy. The self that our minds create is comfortable operating in this environment and can easily hide. Living in the self that God creates seems less easy and requires that we accept that which feels uncomfortable. That is always the way of love. It takes us where we would rather not go. God is good.
