Some random thoughts

The process of transformation is similar to what happens in today's Gospel story, water transforms into wine. Did the water understand why or how this happened? Probably not.... Instead, the water accepted that itself... as wine. When the water accepts that it is wine, it becomes a wonderful vintage. The emphasis in this story (and so much of the Scriptures) is not on orthodoxy (correct thinking) but rather on orthopraxy (correct practicing). Jesus' stories do not teach us ABOUT God. Jesus' stories focus on who God creates us to be and how we are to live who God creates us to be. God is good.
