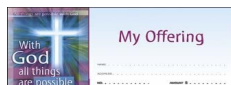

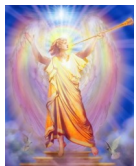
We are grateful to our parish community for all your support and prayers during this unprecedented time. When we are unable to gather to worship together, electronic giving helps stabilize our parish finances.

Some random thoughts

We – it seems – always want a 'go-between' when it comes to God relating with us. Something that isn't possible. The message that Jesus proclaims is that God relates with us directly. Nothing can come between God and us (note Romans 8). Our first reading from Deuteronomy gives us an example of this human tendency. We resist relating directly with God because it can be uncomfortable. Those who claim leadership positions encourage our resistance so that they can protect their power and prestige. Jesus ignores their complaints against him and continues to proclaim God's desire to relate with us directly. God is good.

Parish Updates: The Catholic Charity Appeal will take place in the first part of the Lenten Season. Please note: Due to the pandemic, Ash Wednesday (which falls on February 17th), will be different. We will remind everyone to 'Turn away from sin and believe in the Gospel.' but we will not be placing ashes on individual foreheads.
