Contagious diseases have understandably always frightened people. The fear often led people to treat people with contagious diseases in a less than merciful way. The greatest suffering of those who are contagious is isolation. When leprosy, for example, is discovered in Hawaii, the authorities force anyone who shows signs of leprosy to live on an isolated island without shelter or food. Those who arrive on the island are abandoned and forgotten. Something similar happens in the time of Jesus. The message that Jesus offers is: you are not abandoned or forgotten. You are healed. God is good.
