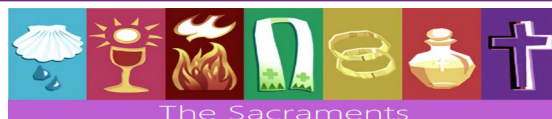
Bible Study will be held on Wednesday evenings,
