Earthquake Relief for Turkey and Syria

On Feb. 6, a 7.8 magnitude earthquake devastated large

areas of central Turkey and northwest Syria. The death toll has surpassed 36,000 and continues to climb. Later that day, the region experienced a second magnitude 7.7 quake. Catholic Relief Services will support emergency relief efforts led by local partners in both Syria and Turkey with Caritas Turkey, Caritas Syria in Aleppo and Lattakia—where extensive damage has been reported—and other local partners.
