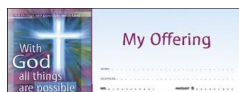

Some random thoughts ...

Do you feel a resistance when you hear, 'God dwells in your enemies?' The accepted teaching for thousands of years is, 'God loves our neighbor and hates our enemies.' The saying, 'God is on our side.' captures this belief and we, without conscious awareness, accent to it. When we experience God dwelling in us, it dawns on us that God dwells in everyone. Jesus, as a result, teaches us to love our enemies. When we fail to recognize God dwelling in our enemies, we fail to recognize the God dwells in ourselves. One thing that makes it difficult for us to recognize God dwelling in our enemies is the teaching that God is completely separate from us (in heaven). The material, the church teaches us, is corrupt and separate from the spiritual. They never meet or connect. One is pure and the other impure. Jesus teaches that the divine can only be found in the material. When we separate the two, the divine can never be found. God is good.
