<u>2023 Guidelines for Lent</u>

Abstinence from meat on the Fridays of Lent (for those 14 and older) is required by Church law. Also, Good Friday is a day of fasting: those between the ages of 18 and 59 should eat less, meaning take no solid food between meals and only one full meal that day. Serious health conditions excuse a person from these precepts. Pastors and parents are encouraged by the law of the Church to ensure that minors who are not bound by the law of fast and abstinence are educated nonetheless in an authentic sense of penance.
