

Some random thoughts ...

Jesus in today's Gospel story from Luke is almost completely vulnerable, which makes him aware of the love that flowed through him. Peter, James, and John see the transfiguration that happens to Jesus, but they do not understand it. They mistake the transfiguration as a sign of power and dominance rather than vulnerability and weakness. cannot exist with power and dominance. The misunderstanding causes them to fall on their faces in fear. It is only when Jesus is arrested and killed and they feel completely vulnerable, the love descends upon them and they too are transfigured. As with the disciples of Jesus the Christ, so too with us. God is good.

Parish Updates ...

Fr. Victor Silva and I met on February 15, 2022. We talked about the ministries, events and buildings of CTK. Fr. Silva has met with some of the staff, and will meet with the Trustees of the Parish (Diane Cyr and Mike Bosworth) in the next month or so. We thought that it would be good to host an open meeting with Fr. Silva. We will soon set a date. (Most likely, the meeting will take place during the Month of May.) All parishioners are welcome to bring whatever questions and/or concerns they might have.

We are viewing a tentative weekend Mass schedule that out-of-necessity requires some change in both St. Anthony Parish and CTK. The **PROPOSED** schedule: Saturday at 4:00 pm (CTK) and 5:15 pm (SA); 8:00 or 8:30 am (SA - Portuguese); 10:00 am (CTK); and 11:15 am (SA). The biggest adjustment for CTK is that the 8:00 am Mass (at CTK) will be eliminated. SA will experience change to three Masses (one in Portuguese). Music (and choir) at CTK will remain the same. Once solidified, the schedule would go into effect the weekend of July 2-3, 2022. Additionally, the Sacrament of Reconciliation will alternate parishes. Finally, the PROPOSAL includes weekday Mass in which the time (for CTK) will change to 8:30, and on Monday & Tuesday at SA, and Wednesday & Friday at CTK. To keep everything in order SA & CTK will have ONE 'Mass Book' (only) for Mass Intentions.

Finally, CTK will continue as a corporation, which means that all assets and debts are the responsibility of CTK. One of Father Silva's roles is to administer the finances of both parishes separately.

Stations of the Cross are offered each Monday during Lent at 6:00 pm. All are welcome to participate.
