BIBLE STUDY

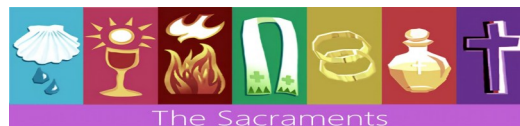
Bible study will be held on Tuesday evenings, *during Lent*, at 6:30PM in Christ the King Parish Center.
