



Some random thoughts

Theologically there are two understandings of the resurrection. The east develops the oldest theology. The theology of the west develops later. Western culture, moving toward intellectualism (clarity and understanding) and individualism (personal salvation) influences this later theology. So western theology depicts Jesus as uniquely rising from the tomb BY HIMSELF. Jesus conquers death alone. Eastern theology continues to connect with mystery (that which is foggy and dark) and community (collective salvation). So eastern theology depicts Jesus rising not uniquely but with an INFINITE MULTITUDE with him. All of creation including humans – moves beyond death – not only Jesus – because God's love is indiscriminate and inclusive of all of creation. God is good.

Parish Updates: Blessed Easter! We are seeing improvements. Last year, we had no liturgical celebration of Holy Week or Easter. That we are free to celebrate communally this year is reason for us to be grateful.
