Some random thoughts

Fr. John LaPointe wrote a homily in March concerning Nicodemus, but his insights equally apply today with Thomas. He wrote, 'IN his questioning AND in his fears and doubts; Nicodemus (or in today's Gospel story, Thomas) is NOT turned away by Jesus, but is welcomed with understanding and compassion. And so today's liturgy reminds us that no matter where you and I may be stuck in one of life's dark shadows, God will send us light. God will never abandon us. God is always reaching out to us again and again. This is the heart of the Good News. God so loved the world that he sent Jesus to be our savior; that even when we were dead in our sins, God brought us back to life again through Christ. Jesus came into this world to save sinners without exception. In spite of our sins, in spite of our violence, in spite of our pride that tells us we don't need God, we are always God's children. This love has no strings attached – by grace we have been saved. Our faith is rooted in this absolute free gift of God, whose only wish is to restore us to the divine image. No one is ever outside the reach of God's mercy, no one.' God is good.
