

Some random thoughts ...

The kindness and mercy of God is experienced when we accept that God creates us and then relates with us mutually and as equals. It has little to do with our receiving absolution from a priest. Our Gospel story from John helps us to see that our wounds offer us opportunities to relate lovingly with God and each other. Our wounds reveal Christ. Unfortunately, we receive training to get rid of our wounds or disguise and hide them. The Twelve Step program begins with the most fundamental truth, we need to see with help from God/Higher Power – and accept our failings. The ways in which we have hurt others and how we have hurt ourselves. Once we accept that we have an addiction, we learn to accept that our addiction lives with us, but does not have to control or direct us. We live in a relationship with a reality who relates with us mutually and with equality. We do not earn equality and mutuality. That is an impossibility. We receive - as a gift - equality and mutuality because God is kind and merciful. God lives in tenacious solidarity with us. God is good.

Parish Updates: The transition from independent parishes to two parishes sharing a priest continues. It might take some time to adjust – in particular – to the revised Mass schedule, but that will happen. The important things (relationships and interacting with each other) will remain. Fr. Victor (Silva) made a change several weeks ago in St. Anthony Parish. The 9:00 Mass in Portuguese was moved to 8:00. Both St. Anthony and CTK will offer a 4:00 vigil Mass on Saturdays. The Mass schedule continues to evolve. All activities and events that CTK holds will continue.
