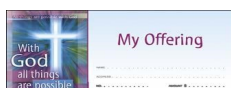

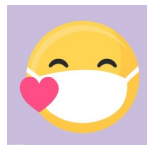

Please note the church office will be closed Friday, April 30th through Tuesday, May 4th.

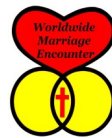


Some random thoughts

Many find it difficult to recognize something positive when we disagree with another person. A thought or a belief creates a bias and our bias blinds us. Almost immediately, we label the other as an enemy (or some other derogatory name). We build a wall. We close and lock the door. We take an untruth and make it truth. Peter finds himself in this situation in our reading from Acts. He asks the leaders and elders, *'What prevents you from seeing the good?'* When doctrines, dogmas, and continuity of thought (our biases), become more important than people and our relationship with people (and creation), we cannot see the good. **God is good.**
