The bank will generate a check and mail it to us as instructed. It's that simple ... you no longer have to be concerned about having the right change or writing a check each week. We have a box on our budget envelopes marked "I Gave Electronically", check the box and place it into the collection basket.

- Demonstrate need by use of the Diocesan Financial Aid Application process (FACTs);

Some random thoughts ...

We have a tendency to make 'prayer' something that we do rather than a visit. When we visit, everything is open-ended. We can talk or be silent. We can be moving or we can be sitting still.
