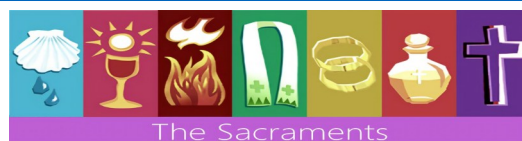
Gratitude is the proper response to a life well-lived for Christ. We thank God for the gift of Pope Francis, whose life bore witness to the Gospel in action.

Catholic School Tuition Financial Assistance



Once again, Church of Christ the King will make available financial aid for families supporting their children in Catholic School Education. Active parishioners may call or email (ctkwwri@cox.net) the office to request an application. Once the Parish has received the necessary information from the Diocese (based on your FACTs application) you will be contacted by the pastor. We ask that those applying for tuition assistance meet the following criteria:

- Participate in the faith and sacramental life of the Parish including the celebration of the mass;
- Demonstrate need by use of the Diocesan Financial Aid Application process (FACTs);
- Volunteer in the parish in one or more ministries/activities.



The Sacraments

Baptism: Call the office six (6) months in advance.

Marriage: Call the office one (1) year in advance.

Adult Confirmation & Baptism: Call the office for information regarding preparation for OCIA, Order of Christian Initiation for Adults.

Anointing of the Sick: Chaplains are on call at the local hospital during the day and in the evenings for emergencies. If you know you are going into the hospital, or know of someone who could use a visit, please do not hesitate to call the office.

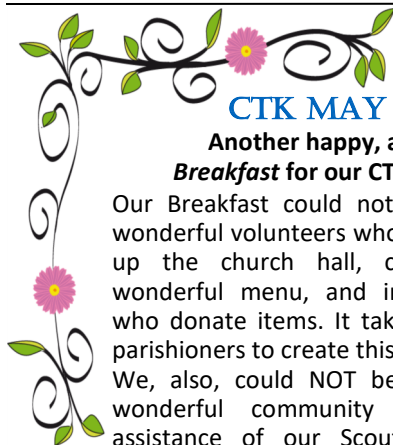
