If you are already enrolled in the **Bill Pay Program** at your financial institution, the set up is a few quick steps! You select the frequency and dollar amount of your donation. The bank will generate a check and mail it to us as instructed. It's that simple ... you no longer have to be concerned about having the right change or writing a check each week. We have a box on our budget envelopes marked "I Gave Electronically", check the box and place it into the collection basket.

- Demonstrate need by use of the Diocesan Financial Aid Application process (FACTs);

Can You Cook a Meal for the Homeless?

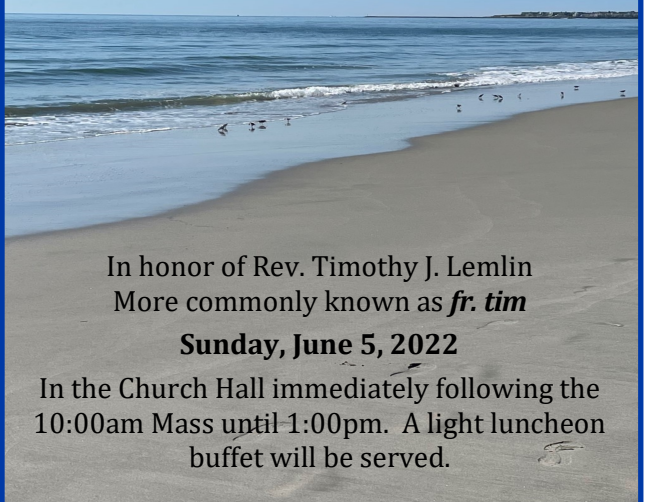
