Some random thoughts ...

Declaring that people are 'martyrs' can give the impression that 'my group' bears the truth and 'you group' are misinformed or liars. The 'prayer' that we hear in today's Gospel from John states clearly that God is not separate from us. God and we are one. The 'we' include everyone and everything, and not just 'my group', as some interpret this passage. Unfortunately, humans are comfortable with separateness. The person that we create (ego) lives because of separateness and distinctions. This egoic need makes us unconscious of our union with God and God flowing through us. Teresa of Avila teaches that 'sense' is important, but overemphasizing 'sense' prevents us from experiencing the intimate love God shares with us. When we know the intimate love God shares with us, we also know the union that we share with each other and all of creation. We stop seeing the earth and people as separate from us, and therefore available for our personal pleasure and gain, we start experiencing a conscious awareness that all are one. God is good.
