Some random thoughts

Unlike some who can conceptualize, I need to see something tangible. It took, for example, multiple years of interactions and viewing the approach used by others before I could make the connection between the concepts of theology I learned in school with the practical theology of parish life. My first attempt at this transition was to teach. It was a valid effort but it failed because I remained in the conceptual realm. The bridge, connecting the two, was finally constructed by moments of suffering and joy that I shared with others. God stopped being a concept and became a relationship. Concepts – good in themselves – tend to shrink our perspective. Relationships – also good in themselves – tend to expand our perspective. Disputed concepts take offense. Disputed relationships seek reconciliation. God is good.
