

Some random thoughts

The prophet, Amos, is a worker. He is not ordained (that is, sacred and set apart) like the priest, Amaziah, who also is part of the king's court. Rather, Amos connects with un-ordained people and creation. The main difference is that Amaziah is separate from everyone except the small circle who hoard power, and manipulate the economy to fulfill their desires by extracting from the poor. This leads to scarcity, famine and death among those who are not part of the small circle, and wastefulness, gluttony and orgies among those who are in the small circle. Amos – like the other prophets – seeks to awaken those who are in the small circle to see the natural outcome of their abuse, and to awaken those who are not in the small circle to see that all that they need can be found in their neighborly connections with each other. Neither message is easy to hear. God is good.
