
Some random thoughts

The actions of the prophets, Elisha and Jesus, are subversive. Unlike the system in which those in authority, extract from the poor to enrich themselves, Elisha and Jesus share and restore (they forgive debts). They ignore the propaganda that the system has the authority to save, and promote the covenant of neighbors. That is, they encourage people to be compassion toward each other. They know that trusting in the system of extraction to provide for the needs of the people, does not work. Instead of provision, such trust brings scarcity, famine, and death. When people relate communally, abundance follows. Concern and compassion for a neighbor is the polar opposite of accusation and judgment. Jesus captures this reality in today's story in John, and again when he says, 'Take and eat ... take and drink.' Who are we to accuse and judge? God is good.
