### Some random thoughts ....

My Dad was a person with conflicting and contrary thoughts and ideas. He wouldn't think twice offering to help when he saw help was needed. Then he would berate people because they were looking for help. He wasn't aware of these conflicting and contrary thoughts and ideas. They were part of the air that he breathed. He had known hunger and poverty, and times when everything was scarce. The unconscious image of God offered to him was that of business manager who kept a ledger. It was an image that developed in the 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> centuries and became part of our culture. (It is an image that continues to be promoted today.) Everything that we receive must be earned. Nothing is freely given! (A message that I often heard.) And yet ... my Dad readily offered help freely to anyone in need of help! The Scriptures are full of conflicting and contrary messages too. One moment we hear, *'All you who are thirsty, come to the water! You who have no money, come, receive grain and eat; come, without paying and without cost, drink wine and milk!'* The next moment we hear, *'You are condemned for you did not do what I expected you to do!'* The stories and actions of Jesus are more consistent. He – as in today's Gospel story – gives freely and with abundance. He has no conditions attached. He doesn't invite people to accept an opportunity, he makes it happen. Most likely, many of us are like my Dad (God knows I am!) and live with conflicting and contrary thoughts and ideas. We are all influenced by our culture. It seems however, the more aware we are of these contradictions within ourselves, the more open we are to freely receive and freely give. God is good.

**Parish Updates:** We need to get creative in order for us to have a Parish Bazaar this year. The restrictions imposed upon us by the Corona Virus almost eliminate any large gatherings. One suggestion, that we have received, is to have a virtual bazaar. This would, unfortunately, eliminate much of the communal interaction that is so important, but it would create some opportunities for community to happen. It would, also unfortunately, prevent some areas not to open, e.g. the kitchen, jewelry, wine and dine, etc., but it would allow most of the 'booths' in which people take chances to be open, e.g. amazing, baskets, etc.
