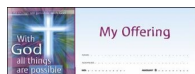

Some random thoughts

When we accept something without any awareness of our acceptance, we walk blindly. I remember the first time I witnessed someone writing with his left hand. It puzzled me. I wondered if writing left-handed broke some law. Silly as this example is, I lived with a priest who refused to give Communion to anyone who placed their right hand on top of their left hand ... because only the right hand could place Communion in the mouth. Jesus tries to help his disciples, in today's Gospel story from Mark, to see. He is not entirely successful. Hidden beliefs and practices are not bad in themselves. If we are not aware, however, of these beliefs and practices, they blind us. Blindness makes us narrow and closed without our knowledge that we are narrow and closed, and justify our actions toward others that are unloving and cruel. God is good.

Parish Updates: Care and concern for each other will continue to dictate what we do and what we ask. We made the difficult choice to cancel the Parish Bazaar, with the multitude of opportunities for people to mingle and come together as a community, out of concern that the event would not be safe. We might have to ask – in the near future - that you wear a mask to Mass once again.
