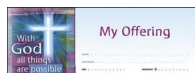

Some random thoughts

For many of us, the way by which we develop an identity is by descriptions (I am smart, I am athletic) and feel that we are real by highlighting our distinctions from others (I am not like that person). We unconsciously tell our-selves that 'I am I by virtue of being not-you.' Such a necessary approach – initially – eventually leads us to feel (consciously or unconsciously) insufficient, vulnerable and always at risk. As a result, we feel insecure and anxious. Jesus teaches us that our true-identity issues forth from God's love and longing for us. Experiencing community (people relating lovingly rather than dominating) can help us see the influences and thoughts passed onto us by family, society and religion that blind us and keep us addicted to power -over others. This is one reason why we offer Communion freely, without restrictions. Otherwise, we cling to an identity created by domination rather than love. God is good.

Parish Updates: Care and concern for each other will continue to dictate what we do and what we ask. We made the difficult choice to cancel the Parish Bazaar, with the multitude of opportunities for people to mingle and come together as a community, out of concern that the event would not be safe. We might have to ask – in the near future - that you wear a mask to Mass once again. It is our hope that we will not have to make such a request, but we wanted to give you a 'heads up' to the possibility.
