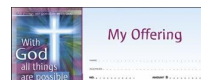

## Some random thoughts ....

It is thought to be blasphemy by many to say that God dwells with everyone. Even if we don't think of it as blasphemy, we interpret that God dwells with everyone, as God dwells with people who are deemed good by us or by some authority. Jesus doesn't make that distinction. He says, 'God is always open.' That is, God dwells with everyone! Today's story in Matthew's Gospel tells us what we do to ourselves and others when we don't experience God dwelling with us: we accuse; we feel self-righteous; we live a lie; we belittle others. Yes, God dwells with all who do these things too. 'Nothing,' Paul the Apostle declares, 'can separate us from the love of God!' God is good.

**Parish Updates:** Our Faith Formation program is completely changed for this coming year. All interactions will be virtual. This will require that a family have a computer and access to Wi-Fi.
