

### Some random thoughts ....

We can tenaciously hold onto an image or belief. This tenacity results in violence as we refuse (because we have to refuse) that our image, our belief isn't the only image, the only belief. (We see this throughout human history into the present time.) We carefully separate ourselves because the image, the belief of others isn't good enough for us. We want something more like our image, our belief. This happens in religion, politics, culture, and between people. Nothing convinces us. Nothing changes us. We are right. We have to be right, because – we say – this is who I am. Then, we can also learn 'the game' of saying all of the right things, but our actions betray us. Somehow we have to experience love unexpectedly and overwhelmingly, so that for a moment we can hear and see that another way exists, and act upon it before our convincing mind has a chance to 'reboot'. Acting on our experience reinforces a different image, a different belief, and change happens to us. 'God is good.

Parish Updates: Our Faith Formation program is completely changed for this coming year. All interactions will be virtual. This will require that a family have a computer and access to Wi-Fi.
