

Some random thoughts

The image of a wedding feast is commonplace in the Scriptures. Unfortunately, we have been taught to focus on the negative (not wearing the correct garment, which is equated with living in sin), rather than the positive. As a result, we miss the invitation, or we do violence by insisting that we must be worthy and/or pure before we accept the invitation; or, because we separate God relating with us in everyday life, we ignore or refuse the The Scriptures definitely give us the impression (in certain places and in certain passages) that God is punitive and retaliatory. As we evolve, however, our image of God evolves, and we are better able to see that God relates with us in a restorative way. God repeatedly makes new covenants with us each time we ignore or refuse to accept God's covenant. God is good.

Parish Updates: Most Parish meetings and gatherings have 'disappeared'. Faith Formation is happening virtually so we don't have the direct contact that we normally have with the young people of CTK. Grandma's Attic is closed indefinitely, so we don't have the continual 'coming and going' of people in the parking lot and store. Bible Study cannot happen. Sunday morning coffee an' isn't possible. But there are some meetings and gatherings that continue to happen and community celebrated. Parishioners continue to be in contact with each other (at Mass, in person, or via the phone). The scouts meet each Wednesday. NA meets on Saturday mornings. And we enjoy parishioners stopping at the Parish Office. The Mass of Remembrance is canceled this year, but we will be remembering all family, friends, and parishioners who have died during the month of November.
