

Some random thoughts

When the prophet, Isaiah, proclaims that Cyrus is God's anointed, many Jews took offense. Cyrus is the king of the Persians, who invaded and conquered the Jews. He is a sworn enemy. How can God say (through Isaiah) that Cyrus is God's representative? Jesus essentially ignores Rome's occupation of Israel. He is tolerant toward the religious leaders (lay and clerical) of his Religion. He remains connected with Judaism but on the margin/ edge. He participates in the Sabbath/Synagogue, but does so in a non-rigid/non-fundamentalist way. He only gets angry when religious leaders (lay and clerical) oppress, dismiss, and judge people as unloved by God. Jesus, as shown in today's Gospel story from Matthew, is practical. Living on the fringe of society and Religion, Jesus has no attachment to money (currency). This detachment frees him to live with fewer entanglements. expectations, and fears. God is good.
