Some random thoughts

The story in our Gospel reading from Mark is a transition story. Jesus and the disciples visit Jericho, which is the lowest point in Palestine. The city is below sea level. Bartimaeus adds emphasis. He is blind and therefore, thought punished by God. He is also the example of the transition. When he discovers that Jesus is passing and calls out to Jesus to save him, healing leads to sight. The actions of the disciples serve as a backup if we miss the transition. Initially, they treat Bartimaeus as a bothersome nobody. They tell him to 'shut up'. They transition into acceptance of him and urge him on when Jesus calls him. Finally, we soon discover that - unlike Bartimaeus - they continue in blindness. Their saving grace is that they do not stop following Jesus. This is our saving grace too. God is good.
