Some random thoughts

The small world that many of us begin with (so that we can grow and develop in a safe environment) is crafted in such a way as to cause us discomfort as we grow and develop! The contradictions that confront us; the tragedies that tear us apart; and the paradoxes that confound us; are all meant to encourage us to kick against the sides of the container, causing it to either expand or fall apart. This can be likened to the two servants who use what is given to them, and expansion happens. The third servant is stifled by fear, and the small world remains the same. Unfortunately, many of us have been taught not to question authorities or God, or are taught to question authorities or God is an unforgivable (mortal) sin. 'Pray, pay, and obey' is the unspoken (or indirectly spoken) mantra that many of us experienced in the atmosphere and environment in which we lived. That changed with the 2nd Vatican Council, though not completely. Some clerics, religious groups, and self-proclaimed leaders continued the mantra, and unfortunately, many more are using it once again. Fear of an unpredictable God who tyrannizes all who are impure or unworthy becomes – once again – the interpretation of this Gospel story. The spin that is used is also familiar to many of us: we are to evangelize non-Catholics and those who are fallen away by having them accept the small world of laws and purity codes of our religion. God invites us to experience love, which always expands and includes. God is good.
