#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING OUR FAITH FORMATION PROGRAM-Please Read Carefully:

All students who are currently registered and not attending Faith Formation classes regularly will be dropped from the rosters as of January 1st. If the family decides to return to classes the following year, then the student will REPEAT the class they did not attend. Lastly, any students in the parish that are in need of First Communion and Confirmation MUST contact the parish office by January 1. After January 1, they will have to register for the following academic year. As of January 1st, we cannot accept or allow non-active students to continue in our program. This new policy is important in maintaining accurate records for sacraments and also ensuring that all students are properly instructed in the faith. Being registered in the Faith Formation Program is simply not enough, we need active participation to bring students into a relationship with Jesus!
