### Some random thoughts ....

The story that Luke offers us concerning Mary (the annunciation, her visiting Elizabeth, the proclamation concerning God, the journey that she and Joseph make to Jerusalem, and the incarnation/ visiting of the shepherds) point to mystery breaking into history. Mystery went out of style with the Age of Enlightenment. We felt everything - with time can be explained by us. Mystery - like - God is infinite. It is not clear. We, at best, catch glimpses and sometimes (maybe often) our glimpses come from times in our lives that are less than pleasant. The mystics refer to these times as darkness, pain, dryness, suffering, nothing, etc. Luke tells us that Mary – like so many other people before and since – struggled with mystery and in her struggle somehow found an openness to God flowing through her. God is good.
